WORKFLOW

The EFACS E/8 Workflow module automates business procedures and improves operational efficiency.

Workflow is especially valuable when the volume of administrative work is high, or where internal organisational procedures require multiple sign-offs, such as approvals in the purchasing process.

EFACS E/8 integrates with email, and task features can be set to ensure work is optomised and complete at the correct time.

KEY COMPONENTS

Bill of materials (BoM) and routing information may be generated with cost roll-ups to provide accurate pricing and product build information to customers and prospects.

Product Configurator works on the basis of a generic bill of materials and associated routings.

These are configured into a specific bill of materials and routings at the point of quotation or order. Controlling the validity of these configurations is important.

Master Production Scheduling (MPS) and Material Requirements Planning (MRP) modules work in tandem to provide accurate planning and control of materials and products.

The Quotation Process, including cost roll-ups, may take place even whilst in discussion with the customer. Coupled with the EFACS E/8 Estimate Due Date functionality, the sales person can also quote an accurate due date.

CRM CONSOLE

The EFACS E/8 CRM Console is one central place for accessing customer and prospect information. Information is displayed in tabs for ease-of-access. Contacts, Addresses, Supported Parts, Service Contracts, Call Centre Cases, Marketing Activity and Sales Opportunities are all visible. In addition, tabs exist for accessing Quotations, Sales Orders, Deliveries and Financial Reports for the specific customer or prospect that is being viewed.

All notes, communications and documents related to the record can also be accessed, viewed and updated.

PRODUCT CONFIGURATOR

Users, either your salesperson or your client, are guided through the product selection options via 'Wizard' style steps, providing an intuitive and simple user experience.

As the product is configured the price is maintained on screen, subtotals are provided for itemised options and accessories where appropriate. Following the selection of available options an image of the final configured product is presented.

The final configured product, once ordered, will define and generate the Bill of Materials, Routing and Technical Specification required to manufacture and fulfil that order.

HIGHLIGHTS

PARTS MASTER

The Parts Master module provides a common, centralised source for vital sales, manufacturing and purchasing information.

A part may be a purchased item, raw material, component, sub-assembly, assembly, finished part or a phantom part.

The powerful EFACS E/8 query system offers great flexibility when searching for like parts, or parts with similar specifications.



HIGHLIGHTS

SFDC

Shop Floor Data Collection (SFDC) module can be utilised via Android touchscreen devices and barcode data capture terminals.

SFDC use is applicable across the shop floor to manage Works Order Receipt, Work in Progress (WIP), Time & Attendance, etc. Its use also covers all elements of the warehouse and stock management, such as Delivery Picking, Stock Receipt and Stock Movement.

Real-time data from the shop floor and warehouse data collection fulfils many functions within EFACS E/8 and is available immediately for accurate forecasting, scheduling and reporting.

FIELD SERVICE MANAGEMENT

The Field Service Management system is a complete service and mobile management solution providing realtime information and resources to field based engineers, delivered directly to their mobile or touchscreen device
